Code of Behaviour

For spectators, players, team & club officials

For spectators, players, team and club officials. Anyone spectating, playing, or performing official duties for your team or Dudley Redhead United must adhere to the following Code of Behaviour.

The code

- **Respect** match officials' decisions.
- **Encourage** — do not ridicule participants for making mistakes.
- **Show respect** for the rights, dignity and worth of every person regardless of their age, gender, gender identity and expression, sexual orientation, ability, race, colour, religion, language, politics, national or ethnic origin.
- **Never use physical force** (violence) in any form towards another person, including spectators, players or match/team officials (including coaches).
- **Do not engage** in acts of discrimination, harassment or abuse towards any person, including:
 - a. the use of obscene or offensive language and/or actions;
 - b. the incitement of hatred or violence.
- **Comply** with all Terms of Admission, including provisions relating to security screening, intoxication, and items that are prohibited by law or restricted by policy from being brought into the venue.
- **No throwing** — missiles, projectiles or objects of any description at players, match officials or fellow spectators is not allowed under any circumstances.

Compliance. Any person who does not comply with the DRUFC Code of Behaviour, or who otherwise causes a disturbance, may be evicted from the venue and may be banned from attending or playing in future matches.
