How to Register

MiniRoos & Community

All registrations are done online through **PlayFootball**, the system used by Northern NSW Football. New and returning players are welcome — from first-kick MiniRoos (Under 6–11) through to all-age football. Just three steps.

How to sign up — three steps

- 1. Sign in to PlayFootball.** Go to playfootball.com.au and either log in or create a new account for your child. You'll need a passport-style photo and proof of date of birth.
- 2. Pick Dudley Redhead United.** Search for "Dudley Redhead United FC", choose the right age group and pay through PlayFootball.
- 3. Pay and await communication.** For MiniRoos (Under 6–11) there are **no gradings** — once you've paid, you're registered. From Under 12, players may attend a short grading session when numbers require it, so everyone plays at a level that suits them. The club will be in touch with team and training details.

What your registration includes

MiniRoos (Under 6–11). Registration with Football Australia, Northern NSW Football, Macquarie Football Association and DRUFC; player insurance; ground fees; and referee fees. Every new player to DRUFC also receives a **complimentary MiniRoos playing jersey**.

Community (ages 12+). The same as MiniRoos — registration at every level, player insurance, ground fees and referee fees — without the complimentary playing jersey.

One fee, all included. A single registration covers your football for the season — federation and club registration, insurance, ground fees and referee fees. Each season's pricing is confirmed at registration and shown on PlayFootball at sign-up.
